Please be sure to label ALL of the following supplies

with your child's first and last name!

- → Backpack or Bookbag (no rolling bags with wheels)
- → 1 plain pocket folder, without brads (red)
- → 2 boxes of 8 count crayons (preferably Crayola)
- → 1 composition notebook with 1 inch ruling
- \rightarrow 1 standard pencil box
- → 2 packages of Clorox wipes
- → 1 box of gallon size Ziplock plastic bags
- → 1 box of sandwich Ziplock plastic bags

The following supplies will be shared by the entire class and do not need to be labeled with names!

- \rightarrow 3 boxes of tissues
- → 4 glue sticks
- → 1 hand sanitizer
- \rightarrow 2 rolls of paper towels
- → 2 package of #2 pencils (8 count)

- → 1 art smock (an old shirt of dad's will do)
